This strong economic base means plenty of opportunities for employment, business, and community investment.

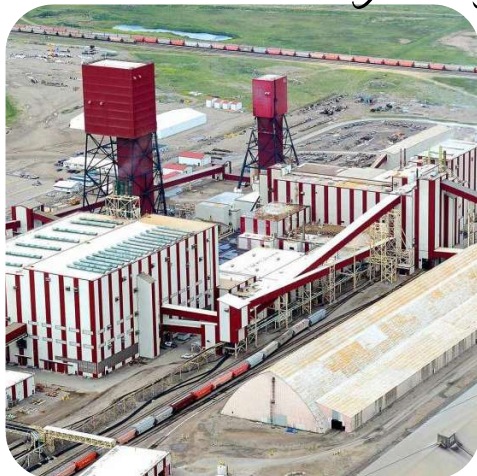
A Connected Community

ESSENTIAL SERVICES

01 Water, Sewer, & Waste Collection

- The Town of Moosomin provides water, sewer, recycling and garbage collection services.
- To set up your account, contact the Town Office at (306) 435-2988 or visit moosomin.com.
- Garbage and recycling are collected bi-weekly. Pick-up schedules are available online or at the Town Office.
- Recycling and garbage bins are provided.

02 Power & Natural Gas

03 Internet, Phone, & TV

04 Postal Services

- Moosomin's Canada Post office is located at 711 Main Street.
- Mailboxes and forwarding services can be arranged in person.

05 Emergency Services

- Fire Department: Volunteer-based, activated through 911
- Ambulance/EMS: Available 24/7 through 911

HEALTHCARE

Moosomin offers access to high-quality healthcare services right in the community, with additional specialized care available nearby.

Moosomin is a family-friendly community with strong educational options and reliable childcare to support working parents and growing families.

Public Schools

Moosomin is part of the Southeast Cornerstone Public School Division and is home to two public schools:
